Worry-Free Moments To-Do List ✓

- Ensure your home has working carbon monoxide alarms installed outside all sleeping areas
- Test your carbon monoxide alarms monthly by pushing the button
- If your carbon monoxide alarm is battery-operated, remember to replace the batteries when the clocks change for daylight savings (twice a year)
- Check the date! Carbon monoxide alarms DO expire – replace your alarm according to the manufacturer's instructions, or every 7 years
- Always react if your carbon monoxide alarm activates. Move your family to a fresh air location outdoors. Call for help from outside and stay there until emergency personnel arrive
